Dirigent dr Milena Injac - Srbija

Dr Milena Injac, dirigent, redovni profesor i dekan Fakulteta umetnosti u Nišu. Doktorirala je Dirigovanje na Fakultetu muzičke umetnosti, Univerziteta umetnosti u Beogradu u klasi prof. emeritus Darinke Matić-Marović. Usavršavala se kod Jorme Panule, Petera Etveša, Mladena Jagušta i Salvadoru Mas Konde u Beču. Horsko pevanje i dirigovanje je usavršavala u Švedskoj kao član prve sesije Svetskog hora, radeći sa Erikom Eriksonom, Stefanom Šoldom i Tomasom Kaplinom. Tokom studija bila je asisten u horovima Collegium musicum i Lola. Po dolasku u Niš bila je dirigent Niškog kamerniog hora, sa kojim je ostvarila brojne koncerete i izvela više vokalno – instrumentalnih dela. Dobitnik je Zlatne značke IHS 2004.

godine za doprinos u radu festivala i izvodjenja svetskih premijera vokalno-instrumentalnih dela. Nekoliko godina je dirigovala Aleksinačkim mešovitim horom „Šumatovac“ sa kojim je osvajala nagrade u Ohridu i Pardubicama. Milena Injac je član i predsednik žirija hoskih takmičenja u Antaliji i Čanakaleu, Turska, počev od 2011. Godine. Osvojila je prvu nagradu na 3. Internacionalnom festivalu „Svet muzike“ u Italiji dirigujući kamernim sastavom Niškog simfonijskog orkestra.

Nastupala je sa gotovo svim vodećim orkestrima u zemlji, operom u Beogradu i Skoplju, kao i muzičkim teatrom u Rimu, svim vodećim orkestrima i filharmonijama u regionu i više puta gostovala u Latinskoj Americi i na festivalima u Urugvaju, El Salvadoru, Velikoj Britaniji, Španiji, Italiji, Bugarskoj, BIH, Makedoniji, Švedskoj, Austriji, Crnoj Gori, Grčkoj i Rusiji. Bila je dirigent scenskih izvodjenja operete J. Strausa: „Slepi miš“ i opere Đ. Rosinija: „Seviljski berberin“, u okviru projekta obnove operske scene u Nišu. Stalni je gost dirigent Niškog simfonijskog orkestra i gostujući predavač dirigovanja na Akademija Diesis u Španiji.



* Dr Milena Injac, conductor, full professor and dean of the Faculty of Arts in Nis. She received her doctorate in conducting at the Faculty of Music, University of Arts in Belgrade under mentorship of prof. emeritus Darinka Matic-Marovic. She is trained with Jorma Panula, Peter Eötvös, Mladen Jagust and Salvador Mas Conda in Vienna and perfected choral singing and conducting in Sweden as a member of the first session of the World Choir, working with Erik Eriksson, Stefan Sköldand and Thomas Kaplin. During her studies, she was an assistant in the 'Collegium musicum' and 'Lola' choirs in Belgrade.

After arriving in Nis, she was the conductor of the Nis Chamber Choir, with whom she performed numerous concerts and several vocal and instrumental works. He won the IHS Golden Badge in 2004 for his contribution to the work of the festival and the performance of world premieres of vocal-instrumental works. For several years, she conducted the Aleksinac Mixed Choir 'Sumatovac', with which she won prizes in Ohrid and Pardubice. Since 2011, Milena Injac has been a member and president of the jury of the sock competition in Antalya and Çankale, Turkey.

She won the first prize at the 3rd international festival "World of Music" in Italy conducting the chamber ensemble of the Nis Symphony Orchestra. She has performed with almost all the leading orchestras in the country, the opera in Belgrade and Skopje, as well as the musical theater in Rome, all the leading orchestras and philharmonics in the region and has been a guest several times in Latin America and at festivals in Uruguay, El Salvador, Great Britain, Spain, Italy, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Sweden, Austria, Montenegro, Greece and Russia. She was the conductor of the stage performances of J. Strauss's operetta: 'The Bat' and the opera G. Rossini: 'The Barber of Seville' in Nis. Milena Injac is a regular guest conductor of the Nis Symphony Orchestra and a guest lecturer of conducting at the Academia Diesis in Spain.

Predsjednik žirija / President of the Jury

Dirigent Jeroen Beckers - Belgija

Jeroen Beckers (rođen 1980.) je studirao na Conservatorium Maastricht, Lemmensinstituut Leuven, južnoholandskom Konzervatoriju za muziku, kao i Konzervatoriju Utrecht, gdje je dobio diplomu iz oblasti teorije muzike, violine, viole i horskog dirigovanja. Naknadno je pohađao master časove za violinu i kamernu muziku kod Kati Sebestijen (Belgija), Zigmunda Kovalskog (Belgija), Fredija Artela (Belgija), Japa Krutofa (Belgija), Donalda Elerona (SAD) i Bendžamina Ravica (Izrael). Takođe je pohađao i časove horskog dirigovanja kod An Mari Kabo (Francuska), Kari Ala-Polanena (Finska), Majkla Gola (Švajcarska) i Dena Saboa (Mađarska). Studirao je i orkestarsko dirigovanje kod Edmonda Savenijera i Patrika Davina.

Kao violinista, sarađivao je sa simfonijskim orkestrom "de Munt", "Brussels Philharmonie - VRO", "Brabants Orkest Eindhoven", "Opéra Royal de Wallonie - Liège", kao i međunarodnim kamernim orkestrom "iPalpiti". Njegove izvedbe dovele su ga do vodećih flamanskih scena, Concertgebouw (Amsterdam), Kimel Centar (Filadelfija) i Karnegi Hol (Nju Jork). Dirigent je horske grupe Cantitare Maaseik i Pro Cantione Genk, a često je i gost dirigent i vođa radionica u zemlji i inostranstvu. U najveća dostignuća njegove karijere ubraja se saradnja sa britanskim kompozitorom/dirigentom Džonom Ruterom, potom dirigovanje francuskim omladinskim horom "La Cygale de Lyon" tokom koncerta u Orebru (Švedska), kao i vođenje mađarskih horova "Cantemus" i "Pro Musica".

Dirigovao je i izvođenjem Hajdnovih i Mocartovih „Rekvijema”, Vivaldijevom „Glorijom”, kao i Dženkinsovom Stabat Masterom. Trenutno radi kao nastavnik na Akademiji umjetnosti Maseik (Belgija), predsjednik je "Flamanske federacije omladinskih horova", i član Borda "Evropske horske asocijacije - Europa Cantat".



Jeroen Beckers (born 1980) studied at Conservatorium Maastricht, Lemmensinstituut Leuven, South Holland Conservatory of Music, as well as Conservatorium Utrecht, where he received a diploma in music theory, violin, viola and choral conducting. He subsequently attended master classes for violin and chamber music with Kati Sebestien (Belgium), Sigmund Kowalski (Belgium), Freddy Artel (Belgium), Jaap Krutoff (Belgium), Donald Elleron (USA) and Benjamin Ravitz (Israel). He also attended choral conducting classes with Anne Marie Cabot (France), Kari Ala-Polanen (Finland), Michael Goll (Switzerland) and Dan Szabo (Hungary).

He also studied orchestral conducting with Edmond Savenier and Patrick Davin. As a violinist, he collaborated with the "de Munt" symphony orchestra, "Brussels Philharmonie - VRO", "Brabants Orkest Eindhoven", "Opéra Royal de Wallonie - Liège", as well as the international chamber orchestra "iPalpiti". Nyag's performances have brought him to the leading Flemish stages,

Concertgebouw (Amsterdam), Kimmel Center (Philadelphia) and Carnegie Hall (New York). He is the conductor of the choir groups Cantitare Maaseik and Pro Cantione Genk, and is often a guest conductor and leader of workshops in the country and abroad. The greatest achievements of his career include the collaboration with the British composer/conductor John Rutter, then conducting the French youth choir "La Cygale de Lyon" during a concert in Örebro (Sweden), as well as conducting the Hungarian choirs "Cantemus" and "Pro Musica".

He also conducted performances of Haydn's and Mozart's Requiems, Vivaldi's Gloria, and Jenkins' Stabat Master. He currently works as a teacher at the Maseik Academy of Arts (Belgium), is the president of the "Flemish Federation of Youth Choirs" and a member of the Board of the "European Choral Association - Europa Cantat".

Dirigent Jasenka Ostojić - Hrvatska

Dirigentica Jasenka Ostojić, redovita je profesorica na Muzičkoj akademiji Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Predaje dirigentske predmete i kolegije Zbor i Komorni zbor s kojima ostvaruje izvrsne vokalno – instrumentalne projekte pohvaljene od strane javnosti i glazbene kritike. Od akademske 2018./2019. godine profesor je i na Muzičkoj akademiji u Sarajevu (Bosna i Hercegovina) gdje predaje dirigiranje i srodne stručne predmete. Predavač je i voditelj seminara i stručnih usavršavanja u zemlji, te gost predavač na sveučilištima u Poljskoj, Austriji, Sloveniji, Srbiji, Bosni i Hercegovini i SAD-u.

Članica je stručnih ocjenjivačkih sudova na natjecanjima dirigenata, orkestara i zborova (Italija, Poljska, Slovenija, Bosna i Hercegovina, Crna Gora, Makedonija i Bugarska). Kao dirigentica zborova i orkestara osvojila je desetke državnih i međunarodnih nagrada, među kojima su i dva međunarodna Grand Prix-a. Bogatu koncertnu djelatnost ostvaruje na uglednim festivalima u Hrvatskoj, te Velikoj Britaniji, Francuskoj, Belgiji, Austriji, Italiji, Sloveniji, Srbiji, Bosni i Hercegovini, Makedoniji, Grčkoj i SAD-u. Ravnala je praizvedbama brojnih skladatelja za čije je izvedbe u nekoliko navrata nagrađena posebnim priznanjima. Kao dirigentica surađivala je sa Zagrebačkim solistima, Hrvatskim komornim orkestrom, Varaždinskim komornim orkestrom, Simfonijskim puhačkim orkestrom OSRH, Zborom Hrvatske radiotelevizije i dr. Specijalizirala je vokalnu izobrazbu pjevača mladalačke dobi kod Bečkih dječaka, Austrija.

Djelovala je kao dirigentica zbora Zagrebački dječaci, te je bila mentor brojnim dječacima koji su u posljednja dva desetljeća nastupali kao solisti u profesionalnim produkcijama nacionalnih opernih i koncertnih kuća. Godine 2006. osniva Hrvatsko društvo Collegium pro arte pri kojem djeluju priznati i nagrađivani zborovi Cappella Zinka i Cappella Odak te ansambala Odak Camerata i Ansambl Celeste, glazbeni teatar. Urednica je zbirke Antologija hrvatske zborske glazbe u izdanju Koncertnog ureda Zadar. Umjetnička je ravnateljica World Choir Festival on Musical, Thessaloniki.



The conductor, Jasenka Ostojić, is a full-time professor at the Music Academy of the University of Zagreb. He teaches conducting courses and Choir and Chamber Choir courses, with which he realizes excellent vocal-instrumental projects praised by the public and music critics. From the academic year 2018/2019. Since 2011, he is also a professor at the Academy of Music in Sarajevo (Bosnia and Herzegovina), where he teaches conducting and related professional subjects. He is a lecturer and leader of seminars and professional training in the country, and a guest lecturer at universities in Poland, Austria, Slovenia, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and the USA.

She is a member of expert judging panels at competitions for conductors, orchestras and choirs (Italy, Poland, Slovenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Macedonia and Bulgaria). As a conductor of choirs and orchestras, she won dozens of national and international awards, including two international Grand Prix. He performs a rich concert activity at prestigious festivals in Croatia, Great Britain, France, Belgium, Austria, Italy, Slovenia, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Greece and the USA. She directed the first performances of numerous composers, for whose performances she was awarded special awards on several occasions. As a conductor, she collaborated with the Zagreb Soloists, the Croatian Chamber Orchestra, the Varaždin Chamber Orchestra, the OSRH Symphony Wind Orchestra, the Choir of Croatian Radio and Television, and others. She specialized in the vocal training of young singers at the Viennese Boys, Austria. She worked as a conductor of the Zagreb Boys Choir, and was a mentor to numerous boys who, in the last two decades, performed as soloists in professional productions of national opera and concert houses. In 2006, he founded the Croatian society Collegium pro arte, where the recognized and award-winning choirs Cappella Zinka and Cappella Odak, as well as the Odak Camerata ensemble and the Celeste Ensemble, musical theater, operate. She is the editor of the Anthology of Croatian Choral Music collection published by the Zadar Concert Office. She is the artistic director of the World Choir Festival on Musical, Thessaloniki.

Djevojački hor „Aurin“ Kecskemét, Mađarska / Aurin Girls' Choir B

Djevojački hor „Aurin“ je osnovan 1998. godine u čuvenoj školi Kodali u Kečkemetu, od djevojčica starijih od 15 godina koje su ranije bile članice dječjeg hora Mirakulum. Sada je hor među najboljim omladinskim horovima u Evropi. Osnivač i direktor hora je Laslo Duranjik. Ciljevi hora su: da igra važnu ulogu u kulturnom životu našeg grada, da bude dio mađarskog muzičkog života, da uspješno učestvuje na domaćim i međunarodnim koncertima, festivalima i horskim takmičenjima, da pravi kvalitetne snimke i da predstavlja Kodalijev rodni grad, Kečkemet, na prikladan način širom svijeta.

Djevojačkom horu do 2017. dodeljena je 21 prva nagrada. Osvojile su prve nagrade u Riva del Gardi, Debrecinu, Kalundborgu, Gradu, Budimpešti, Llangolenu, Leku, Krakovu, Vroclavu, Ohridu, postale su olimpijske šampionke u Kini, osvajale su druge i treće nagrade u Maasmechelenu, Celju i Arecu. U toku festivala i koncertnih turneja djevojke su posjetile mnoge zemlje: Englesku, Vels, Škotsku, Norvešku, Dansku, Belgiju, Nemačku, Švajcarsku, Slovačku, Sloveniju, Češku, Italiju, Španiju, Rumuniju, Francusku, Kinu, Poljsku, Kipar, Makedoniju i Bugarsku. Hor se uvijek trudi da dopuni svoj repertoar, zasnovan na muzici renesanse do muzike 20. vijeka, sa posebnim osvrtom na horska djela Kodalija, Bartoka, Bardoša, Kočara i Orbana.



The AURIN GIRLS' CHOIR was formed in 1998 in the famous Kodály School of Kecskemét, of girls over 15 who were previously members of the Miraculum Children's Choir. Now the choir is among the best youth choirs in Europe. The founder and director of the choir is [László Durányik](#).

The choir's aims are: to play an important role in the cultural life of our town, to be part of Hungarian musical life, to take part successfully in national and international concerts, festivals and choir competitions, to make high quality recordings and to represent Kodály's home-town, Kecskemét, in a fitting way all over the world.

The Girls' Choir has been awarded 21 first prizes up to 2017. They won 1st prizes in Riva del Garda, Debrecen, Kalundborg, Grado, Budapest, Llangollen, Lecco, Krakow, Wroclaw, Ohrid, they became Olympic Champions in China, they won 2nd and 3rd prizes in Maasmechelen, Celje, Arezzo. The girls visited a plenty of countries for festivals, concert tours: England, Wales, Scotland, Norway, Denmark, Belgium, Germany, Switzerland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Slovenia, Italy, Spain, Romania, France, China, Poland, Cyprus, Macedonia, Bulgaria.

The choir is always trying to augment its repertoire, which is based on Renaissance to 20th century music, with a special focus on choral works by Kodály, Bartók, Bárdos, Kocsár and Orbán.

Dirigent: Anna Tarnowska

Počeci univerzitskog hora u Šćećinu datiraju iz 1969. godine. Tada je to bio ansambl Više pedagoške škole u Šćećinu, koja je 1985. transformisana u univerzitet. Do 2005. umjetnički direktor i dirigent bio je profesor Eugenijus Kus, dugogodišnji direktor Zamka Pomeranskog vojvode. Oktobra 2006. osnovan je novi pjevački ansambl na Fakultetu za ekonomiju i menadžment, na Univerzitetu u Šćećinu – osnovan je na inicijativu tadašnjeg dekana Fakulteta za ekonomiju i menadžment, profesora Edvard Urbanjik i dr Tadeuš Bučkovski, dirigent sa dugogodišnjim iskustvom. Vremenom je ansambl postao zvanični hor američkog univerziteta. Preko godine, hor SAD je izveo stotine koncerata u Poljskoj i inostranstvu. Pjevalo se i jedno i drugo, a cappella komadi i velika vokalna i instrumentalna djela. Jezgro ansambla čine studenti, diplomci i akademici univerziteta, a upotpunjuje ga grupa šćećinske muzike i pjevanja i mnogobrojni entuzijasti. U početku je ansambl nastupao uglavnom na važnim univerzitskim svečanostima. Hor je dao mnoge koncerte širom zemlje. Dobio je nagrade i priznanja na takmičenjima i smotrama horova u Bedzinu, Helmno i Kielce, kao i u inostranstvu, uključujući Belgiju, Njemačku, Francusku, Švajcarsku i Bugarsku. Najvažniji nastupi tokom turneja bili su u oba doma Evropskog parlamenta, u Briselu i Strazburu. Hor je 2016. godine dobio statuetu Lovora kulture Zapadne Pomerenije, koju dodjeljuje Šćećinsko Kulturno Društvo za cjelokupnu umjetničku djelatnost, kao i nagrade Poljske asocijacije Horova i orkestara. Hor je 2017. godine odlikovan Srebrnom značkom časti Zapadne Pomerenije Grifin od maršala Zapadnopomeranskog vojvodstva. Pored toga, hor Univerziteta u Šćećinu bio je organizator cikličnih ljetnjih univerzitskih koncerata pod pokroviteljstvom Ministarstva kulture i Nacionalne baštine, tokom koje su, zajedno sa dirigentima svjetske klase, profesionalnim muzičarima i profesionalnim solistima je izvodila velika muzička djela u Šćećinu, Volinu, Kobilanci i Kamenju Pomorskom, između ostalih, snimljeno na pet DVD-a. U martu 2022. dr Tadeuš Bučkovski, dosadašnji dirigent i umjetnički direktor ansambla, je zamijenila dr Ana Tarnovska, profesorka na Akademiji umjetnosti u Šćećinu. Zajedno sa novim dirigentom, Američkom horu pridružili su se novi glasovi iz prethodno vođenog mješovitog hora Soli Deo, čiji je ženski dio nastupao pod nazivom „Gioia di Canto”, postigao je brojne uspjehe, uključujući u junu 2021. 56. Međunarodnog festivala horske pjesme u Mjedzizdroju, nagrađen je Zlatnom diplomom i peharom Predsjednika poljskog udruženja horova i orkestara u Šćećinu, kao i zlatnu diplomu i dva specijalna odlikovanja na 20. Međunarodnom festivalu horske muzike Feliks Novoviejski u Barčevu ili 2. mjesto i Zlatna diploma osvojena u novembru 2021. na 51. Turniru narodnih horova u Legničkom kantatu.





Novembar 2022. doneo je horu SAD dalje uspehe – dve zlatne diplome i specijalnu nagradu na 7. Međunarodni festival horske muzike Cantates Lublinensis 2022 u Lublinu.

The beginnings of the Szczecin University Choir date back to 1969. At that time it was the ensemble of the Higher School of Pedagogy in Szczecin, which was transformed into a university in 1985. Until 2005, the artistic director and conductor was Professor Eugenius Kus, the long-time director of the Castle of the Pomeranian Dukes. In October 2006, a new singing ensemble was established at the Faculty of Economics and Management of the University of Szczecin - founded on the initiative of the then Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Management, Professor Edward Urbańczyk, and Dr Tadeusz Buczkowski, a conductor with many years of experience. Over time, the ensemble became the official choir of the US university. Over the many years of its activity, the US Choir has performed hundreds of concerts in Poland and abroad. It sang both a cappella pieces and large-scale vocal and instrumental works. The core of the ensemble is made up of students, graduates and academics of the university, and is completed by a group of Szczecin music and singing enthusiasts. Initially the ensemble performed mainly at important university ceremonies. The choir has given many concerts around the country. It received prizes and awards at competitions and choir reviews in Będzin, Chełmno and Kielce, as well as abroad, including Belgium, Germany, France, Switzerland and Bulgaria. The most important performances during the tours were at both houses of the European Parliament, in Brussels and Strasbourg. In 2016, the Choir received the statuette of the West Pomeranian Laurel of Culture, awarded by the Szczecin Cultural Association for its overall artistic activity, as well as awards from the Polish Association of Choirs and Orchestras. In 2017, the Choir was awarded the Silver Badge of Honour of the West Pomeranian Griffin by the Marshal of the West Pomeranian Voivodeship. ...

Hor „Lira“ osnovan je 1998. godine kao ženski djevojački hor. Od kraja 2018. godine horom diriguje mr Mirjam Marković, te hor postaje mješoviti i dobija naziv Mješoviti gradski hor „Lira“. Trenutno horom diriguje mr Minja Šukalo, a hor se takmiči u kategoriji ženskih horova uslijed nedostatka dovoljnog broja muških članova. U horu ima oko 25 aktivnih članova koji su amaterski pjevači, a čine ga članovi različitih uzrasta od 14 do 60 godina, različitih zanimanja i profesija, ali ih sve zajedno spaja ljubav prema muzici i horskom pjevanju. Hor učestvuje na svim manifestacijama u gradu, od kojih izdvajajmo „Svetosavsku akademiju“, „Svečana akademija povodom Dana grada“, „Izbor sportiste godine“ i druge. Repertoar hora čini svjetovna muzika i to: etno pjesme, umjetničke kompozicije, popularne pjesme zabavne i pop muzike, kao i duhovna muzika. Kompozicije izvodi kako cijelokupan hor, tako i vokalne grupe, uz instrumentalnu pratnju, ali i a capella. Određene kompozicije su sa koreografijom hora, te određenim svjetlosnim, kao i zvučnim efektima. Hor izvodi kompozicije na raznim jezicima. Iako je pandemija spriječila hor da radi u punom kapacitetu, tokom perioda zabrane okupljanja, hor je snimio spot virtuelnog hora, što je motivisalo članove za rad u ovom periodu. I pored prekida rada, hor je imao značajne nastupe i to u emisiji RTRS-a, „Karavan“, gdje je hor nastupao uživo, takođe nastup u jutarnjem programu RTRS-a, u cilju promocije koncerta hora, koji je održan u septembru na ljetnoj sceni ispred Kulturnog centra Gradiška, pred mnogobrojnom publikom, od kada hor tradicionalno održava svoj godišnji koncert u tom periodu. U oktobru 2021. godine MGH „Lira“ uspješno se predstavio na međunarodnom festivalu horova „Banjalučki horski susreti“, a u martu 2022. godine održao koncert sa horom „Jedinstvo“ iz Banja Luke i horom Hrama Svetog Save iz Beograda u Muzeju Republike Srpske u Banja Luci. Hor je 2022. godine nastupio na Međunarodnom horskom festivalu „Majske muzičke svečanosti“ u Bijeljini u kategoriji ženskih horova, osvojio zlatnu medalju, te bio pobjednik kategorije, a na istom takmičenju je sa mješovitim sastavom osvojio zlatnu medalju u kategoriji mješovitih horova. Iste godine mješoviti hor je na Internacionalnim horskim svečanostima u Nišu dobio nagradu za posvećenost u njegovanju amaterskog pjevanja, a ženski hor je dobio pohvalu. Hor je na Međunarodnom festivalu horova u Herceg Novom 2022. godine osvojio zlatnu medalju, a 2023. godine srebrnu medalju. Osim navedenog, treba spomenuti da je hor u protekloj godini učestvovao i na Međunarodnom festivalu horova u Ohridu, koji je revijalnog tipa. U tekucoj 2024. godini Gradski hor „Lira“ osvojio je zlatnu medalju u kategoriji ženskih horova, na festivalu Majske muzičke svečanosti u Bijeljini, te zabilježio niz zapaženih nastupa na gradskim manifestacijama i akademijama.





Choir "Lira" was founded in 1998 as a female choir. Since the end of 2018, the choir has been conducted by Mirjam Marković, and the choir has become mixed and received the name "Lira" Mixed City Choir. Currently, the choir is conducted by Minja Šukalo, and the choir competes in the category of women's choirs due to the lack of a sufficient number of male members. There are about 25 active members in the choir who are amateur singers, and it consists of members of different ages from 14 to 60 years old, of different occupations and professions, but they are all united by their love for music and choral singing. The choir participates in all the events in the city, among which the "Svetosava Academy", "Ceremonial Academy on the occasion of the City Day", "Selection of the Athlete of the Year" and others were highlighted. pop music as well as spiritual music. The compositions are performed both by the entire choir and vocal groups, with instrumental accompaniment, but also a capella. Certain compositions are with choir choreography, and certain light and sound effects. The choir performs compositions in various languages. Although the pandemic prevented the choir from working at full capacity, during the ban on gatherings, the choir recorded a video of the virtual choir, which motivated the members to work during this period. Despite the interruption of work, the choir had significant performances in the RTRS show, "Caravan", where the choir performed live, as well as a performance in the morning program of RTRS, in order to promote the choir's concert, which was held in September at the summer on the stage in front of the Gradiška Cultural Center, in front of a large audience, since when the choir traditionally holds its annual concert in that period. Despite the interruption of work, the choir had significant performances in the RTRS show, "Caravan", where the choir performed live, as well as a performance in the morning program of RTRS, in order to promote the choir's concert, which was held in September at the summer on the stage in front of the Gradiška Cultural Center, in front of a large audience, since when the choir traditionally holds its annual concert in that period. In October 2021, MGH "Lira" successfully presented itself at the international choir festival "Banjalučki choral meetings", and in March 2022 held a concert with the choir "Jedinstvo" from Banja Luka and the choir of the Temple of Saint Sava from Belgrade at the Museum of the Republic of Srpska in Banja Luka. ...

Kamerni hor Musica viva osnovan je 2006. godine. Ima oko 30 pjevača iz Tolmina i okolnih sela. Chamber choir Musica Viva was established in 2006. There are around 30 singers from Tolmin and surrounding villages. The main mission of the choir is, due to its specific geographical position, its great care to preserve and promote Slovenian choir tradition, which is especially strong in this part. It was the song and singing that was used as a means of national identity and as well the evidence of belonging to Slovenian culture. In its eighteen-year existence, the choir has gone through numerous concerts. It hasn't neglected traditional elements of Slovenian folk music, it has as well have been dealing with the promotion of modern, contemporary creativity, especially of the Slovenian musicians. U julu 2024. godine hor je dobio povelju za koherentno izvođenje crnogorske horske muzike na festivalu Niške svečanosti. Od 2020 godine hor takođe djeluje kao Ekumenski hor Konkatedrale Svetog Petra u Baru.



Choir "Zima" is an amateur choral society from Bar (Montenegro). Currently, the choir includes several groups of different ages and a chamber choir for adults. The choir is a bronze and several times silver laureate of the international choir competition in Herceg Novi, a participant in the Bar Chronicle festival (2017), a participant in the Ziva ulica festival (2017) in Kolasin, a participant in the Dukley Gardens Christmas festival (2016, 2017). Profesor muzike Elvedin Muminović (rođen 1978 u Tuzli), završio MA 2001 godine u Sarajevu na TPO odsjeku. Diplomirao na temi: „RAZVOJ MUZIKE U ŽIVINICAMA OD PRVIH POZNATIH PODATAKA DO 2000-TE GODINE“. Jedno vrijeme djelovao kao nastavnik harmonike gdje je ostvarivao zavidne rezultate na Federalnom takmičenju harmonikaša. Danas djeluje kao nastavnik solfegia u OMŠ „Živinice“ i obnaša funkciju predsjednika Muzičko obrazovnog centra „Magnifico“. Godine 2010. pokrenuo je Gradski mješoviti hor „Živinice“ koji je uspješno vodio dvije i po godine. Nakon godinu dana djelovanja sa istim horom nastupa na Bijeljinskom takmičenju „Majski cvijet“, gdje je osvojio visoku treću nagradu u veoma jakoj konkurenciji.

Godine 2020. ponovo se aktivira i vodi dva VA Magnifico i Libero. Nakon 8 mjeseci djelovanja VA „Magnifico“ uzimaju učešće na Medjunarodnom horskom šampionatu „Lege Artis“ u Tuzli i osvajaju treću nagradu. The female vocal ensemble "Libero" was founded as an informal group of citizens on November 16, 2020. The ensemble consists of 15 members aged 16 - 58 years. With the formation of the Magnifico Music Education Center, they become its members and continue to work at the same. The ensemble takes part in all important dates for the municipality and the Tuzla Canton, such as: Final concert for Diaspora Days on 31 December 2020 in Živinice Grad. Concert for the Summer Days of the Diaspora 2021 and the Days of International Cuisine 2021-2022. In 2022, they took part in two international festivals where they created very notable results. Bijeljina - Musical May Festival - First Prize, and Choir Festival in Herceg Novi - Second Prize. In the course of 2023, they also took part in two international festivals where they achieved the same results: Bijeljina - May Music Festival - First Prize, and Choir Festival in Herceg Novi - Second Prize. This year, 2024, they took part in the International Choir Championship "Lege Artis" Tuzla and won the First Prize. Recorded 4 videos that are broadcast on local and cantonal television. They regularly take part in enriching TV content on RTV Živinice and RTV TK.

Professor of music Elvedin Muminović (born in 1978 in Tuzla), completed his MA in 2001 in Sarajevo at the TPO department. Graduated on the subject: DEVELOPMENT OF MUSIC IN ZIVINICE FROM THE FIRST KNOWN DATA TO THE YEAR 2000. For a time he worked as an accordion teacher where he achieved enviable results at the Federal Accordion Competition. Today, he works as a solfeggio teacher in the Živinice primary school and holds the position of president of the Magnifico Music Education Center. Vokalna grupa Mezzo okuplja pjevačice i ljubiteljice muzičke umjetnosti iz Novog Mesta i bliže okoline, koje povezuje ljubav prema muzici i umjetničkom stvaralaštvu. Na muzičkoj sceni su aktivne od 2010. godine i do danas su postigle mnoge značajne takmičarske rezultate, nastupe, koncerte, gostovanja, mnogo prepjevanih pjesama, saradnji i, prije svega, lijepih muzičkih trenutaka. Repertoar vokalne grupe rastao je i razvijao se zajedno sa članicama grupe, obuhvatajući ozbiljan takmičarski, revijalni i sakralni program iz različitih perioda muzičke istorije. The vocal group Mezzo brings together female singers and lovers of musical art from Novi Mesto and the surrounding area, who share a love for music and artistic creativity. They have been active on the music scene since 2010 and have achieved many significant competition results, performances, concerts, guest appearances, many sung songs, collaborations and, above all, beautiful musical moments. The repertoire of the vocal group grew and developed together with the members of the group, including a serious competition, revue and sacred program from different periods of musical history. The vocal group regularly participates in competitions in Slovenia and abroad, in revues and independent concerts, collaborates with various composers, soloists and vocal groups, thereby contributing to the diversity of the local music scene. Now, he traditionally organizes two solo concerts a year: one in the holidays around Christmas, and the other at the end of the season with summer serenades. The vocal group Mezzo has been led and

directed by the conductor Professor Barbara Lotrič with her positive enthusiasm and knowledge from the very beginning.

Horski ansambl „Anima“ osnovan je u martu 2023. godine pod pokroviteljstvom Fondacije Priština u Budvi. Uglavnom se sastoji od diplomaca fondacije, hor je multinacionalan. Na repertoaru je više od 14 pjesama različitih žanrova na ukrajinskom, ruskom, engleskom, hrvatskom i gruzijskom jeziku. Grupa aktivno izvodi koncerte. Učestvuje u projektu Fondacije Priština „Podrum“, učestvovao je na koncertnom maratonu „Reforum Spice Budva.“

U aprilu 2024. godine nastupio je na projekciji filma Taje Zubove „Teritorija bez rata“, na Prolećnom forumu ruskog govornog područja dijaspore. Crne Gore u Fondaciji Priština organizovan je koncert sa studentima 1. stepena na Barskom festivalu Program Zajedno“. Grupa učestvuje u dobrotvornim projektima i sarađuje sa budvanskim muzičarima. Ime grupe se pojavilo nedavno. „Anima“ u prevodu znači "duša". Sve pjesme hora govore o miru, dobroti, ljubavi i ljudskom jedinstvu.



Direktor hora je Irina Ždanova. Završila je muzičku školu i muzički koledž u klasi harmonike u Tbilisiju i muzički i pedagoški fakultet univerziteta u Rusiji. Posjeduje veliko iskustvo u nastavi i izvođenju. U Crnoj Gori je dvije godine, aktivno se bavi nastavom i izvođenjem muzike.

The choir ensemble "Anima" was founded in March 2023 under the auspices of the Pristanishte Foundation in Budva. It mainly consists of graduates of the foundation, the choir is multinational. The repertoire includes more than 14 songs of different genres in Ukrainian, Russian, English, Croatian and Georgian. The group is actively performing concerts. Participates in the Pristanishte Foundation's project "Podrum", took part in the concert marathon "Reforum Spice Budva. In April 2024, he performed at the screening of Taya Zubova's film "Territory Without War", at the Spring Forum of the Russian-Speaking Diaspora of Montenegro. A concert with students from Seattle was organized at the Pristanishte Foundation. In June, he received a 1st degree laureate diploma at the Bar Arts Festival. A joint concert with the Belarusian dance ensemble "Voloshki" took place in the "We Are Together" program. The group participates in charity projects and collaborations with musicians from Budva. The group's name appeared recently. "Anima" means "soul" in translation. All the choir's songs are about peace, kindness, love, and human unity.

Hor i orkestar „Attendite!” Kulturnog centra Kikinda osnovan je 2018. godine sa željom za stvaranjem reprezentativnog sastava, koji će našu ustanovu, ali pre svega grad Kikindu predstavljati na značajnim događajima. Hor i orkestar su pod upravom je prof. dr Biljane Jeremić, vrhunskog stručnjaka za muziku i horsko pevanje, kao i višestruko nagrađivanog dirigenta sa nagradama na domaćim i međunarodnim takmičenjima. Pored svog rada sa horom i orkestrom prof. Jeremić predaje na Pedagoškom fakultetu u Somboru i Akademiji umetnosti u Novom Sadu, a kao gostujući predavač održala je predavanja na mnogim fakultetima u zemiji i inostranstvu. Iako iza sebe nema mnogo godina postojanja, svakim nastupom hor i orkestar „Attendite!” izaziva veliku pažnju ne samo lokalne javnosti, već i šire, a u od 2022. u svom sastavu ima i dečiji hor „Kikindijanci”. Do sada hor iza sebe ima niz nagrada među kojima možemo istaći Zlatne medalje specijalne nagrade na horskom festivalu Majske muzičke svečanosti u Bijeljini 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022. i 2023. godine. Hor je proglašen i za apsolutnog pobednika na festivalu Fonfest u Brčkom sa zlatom u tri kategorije. Pored ovih nagrada možemo istaći zlatnu plaketu na festivalima u Bugarskoj i Turskoj (Istanbul) kao i međunarodnom festivalu horova održanom 2019. godine u Kolarcevoj zadužbini u Beogradu. Kao posebne nastupe možemo izdvojiti otvaranje prolećnog zasedanja Narodne skupštine Republike Srbije gde je hor izveo himnu Srbije, nastup na otvaranju Skupštine evropskih regiona u Skupštini AP Vojvodine kao i specijalno pripremjen nastup za doček državne delegacije Kraljevine Norveske. Izuzetno značajan nastup možemo istaći gala koncert hora i orkestra „Attendite!” sa primadonom Jadrankom Jovanović na svečanom otvaranju najznačajnije gradske manifestacije „Dani ludaje”. Hor je od 2020. godine, uz Kulturni centar, domaćin Međunarodnog horskog festivala „Melodianum” u Kikindi. Danas hor i orkestar „Attendite!” broji gotovo 70



članova, odnosno pevača i muzičara koji zajednički rade kako bi grad Kikindu predstavili u najboljem svetlu.

The "Attendite!" Choir and Orchestra of the Kikinda Cultural Center was founded in 2018 with the desire to create a representative ensemble, which will represent our institution, but above all the city of Kikinda, at important events. The choir and orchestra are under the direction of Prof. Dr. Biljana Jeremic, a top expert in music and choral singing, as well as a conductor with multiple awards at domestic and international competitions. In addition to his work with the choir and orchestra, Prof. Jeremic teaches at the Faculty of Education in Sombor and the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad. lectures at many faculties in the country and abroad, there are hardly any years of existence behind them, with every performance the choir and orchestra "Attendite!" causes great attention not only to the local public, but also to the wider public, and since 2022 it has also included the children's choir "Kikindijanci". So far, the choir has won a number of awards, among which we can highlight gold medals and special awards at the choir festival of the May Music Festival in Bijeljina 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023. The choir was declared the absolute winner at the Fonfest festival in Breko with gold in three categories. In addition to these awards, we can highlight the gold plaque at the festivals in Bulgaria and Turkey (Istanbul) as well as the international choir festival held in 2019 at the Kolarc Foundation in Belgrade. As special performances, we can single out the inauguration of the spring session of the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia where the choir performed the national anthem of Serbia, a performance at the opening of the Assembly of European Regions in the Assembly of AP Vojvodina, as well as a specially prepared performance for the reception of the state delegation of the Kingdom of Norway. We can point out the gala concert of the choir and orchestra, "Attendite!", as an extremely impressive performance. with prima donna Jadranka Jovanovic at the ceremonial opening of the city's most important manifestation, "Crazy Days". Since 2020, the choir, together with the Cultural Center, has hosted the International Choir Festival "Melodianum" in Kikinda. Today, the choir and orchestra "Attendite!" has almost 70 members, i.e. singers and musicians who work together to present the city of Kikinda in the best light.

“Prvo pevačko društvo 1905” Šabac, Srbija / „First singing society” 1905 D

Hor je zaživio 1864. godine. Dozvolu za rad „Ministarstva просвећења“ je dobio 1865. godine, pod nazivom „Šabačko pevačko društvo“. U istoriji ŠPD značajna su dva perioda: Robert Tolinger je vodio hor od 1902 do 1911. godine. Treba podsjetiti na 1903. godinu kada je ŠPD učestvuje na „A utakmici srpskih pevačkih društava“ u Beogradu. Ta pobjeda je utoliko značajnija jer je žirijem predsjedavao Stevan Stojanović Mokranjac. Drugi značajan period je 1905. godina kada se oko hora okupljaju folklorni ansambl, narodni orkestar, duvački orkestar, tamburaški orkestar i nastaje KUD „Abrašević“ Šabac. Do danas je hor satavni dio KUD –a, pored mješovitog hora, kao muška pjevačka grupa pod nazivom „Prvo pevačko društvo 1905.“ (skraćeno: „PPD 1905.“). Prvu godinu muški hor je vodio profesor Mladen Kaličanin, ali je zbog bolesti prinuđen da prekine saradnju. Nastavlju sa radom, angažuju Mr Mirjanu Pantelić.



Od 2024. horom rukovodi Nemanja Petrović. Mladi dirigent unosi novu svježinu i potreban kvalitet za dalji razvoj hora. Repertoar hora je raznolik: izvorna muzika, starogradske pjesme, gospel, duhovna muzika, muzika drugih naroda. Nastupali su na mnogim festivalima i takmičenjima, osvojili nagrade i priznanja, od zlatnih medalja do zahvalnice Zahvalnice Dositej Obradović. Njihovo iskustvo kaže da se horsko pjevanje vraća na velika vrata. Shodno tome, grad Šabac proglašava „PPD 1905“ svojim resursom. „PPD 1905“ sarađuje sa mnogim horovima.



Ostvarili su saradnju i sa Fakultetom Muzičke Umetnosti u Beogradu i Akademijom Umetnosti u Novom Sadu. Ovu godinu obilježava saradnja sa Akademskim horom Collegium musicum, sa

kojima su nastupili u Narodnom pozorištu u Beogradu, povodom svečane akademije „Dositejevi dani“, a u Zvezdara teatru po ideji i na poziv akademika Dušana Kovačevića. Na Kolarcu ponovo nastupaju zajedno sa horovima Collegium musicum, horom Muzičke akademije i simfonijskim orkestrom iz Beograda.

The choir came to life in 1864. In 1865, he received a license for the work of the "Ministry of the Enlightened", under the name "Sabačko Pečačko društvo". Two periods are significant in the history of ŠPD: Robert Tollinger led the choir from 1902 to 1911. It should be remembered in 1903, when ŠPD participated in the "A match of Serbian singing societies" in Belgrade. That victory is all the more significant because the jury was chaired by Stevan Stojanović Mokranjac. Another significant period is the year 1905, when the folklore ensemble, folk orchestra, brass band, and tambura band gather around the choir and the KUD "Abrasevic" Šabac is born.

To this day, the choir is a regular part of KUD, in addition to the mixed choir, as a male singing group under the name "Prvo pevacko društvo 1905" (abbreviated: PPD 1905). The first year the male choir was led by professor Mladen Kalicanin, but due to illness he was forced to stop the collaboration. They are continuing their work, hiring Mr. Mirjana Pantelić. Since 2024, the choir has been directed by Nemanja Petrović. The young conductor brings new freshness and necessary quality for the further development of the choir. The repertoire of the choir is diverse: original music, old town songs, gospel, spiritual music, music of other nations. They performed at many festivals and competitions, won prizes and awards, from gold medals to a certificate of appreciation from the Dositej Obradović Foundation. Their experience says that choral singing is making a big comeback. Accordingly, the City of Šabac declares "PPD 1905" as its resource. "PPD 1905" cooperates with many choirs. They also collaborated with the Faculty of Music in Belgrade and the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad. This year is marked by cooperation with the Collegium Musicum Academic Choir, with whom they performed at the National Theater in Belgrade, on the occasion of the Academy's "Dosite Days", and at the Zvezdara Theater at the suggestion and invitation of academician Dusan Kovacevic. In Kolarac, they perform again together with the choirs of the Collegium musicum, the choir of the Academy of Music and the symphony orchestra from Belgrade.

Kulturno umjetničko društvo "Stiv Naumov" - Bitolj je udruženje, osnovano 11. novembra 1944. godine u Bitolju, od strane grupe entuzijastičnih članova 7. makedonske partizanske brigade. Stiv Naumov je u proteklih 76 godina nastavio, obogatio i osmislio tradiciju horske muzike u Bitolju. Učestvovali smo na stotinama koncerata u rodnom gradu, u Republici Makedoniji, širom Balkana i inostranstvu: Bugarskoj, Grčkoj, Turskoj, Rumuniji, Mađarskoj, Italiji, Slovačkoj, Poljskoj, Nemačkoj, Francuskoj, Korzici (Francuska), Sloveniji, Hrvatskoj, Srbija, Bosna i Hercegovina gdje smo osvojili brojne nagrade i priznanja. Tokom 76 godina rada ansambla održali smo oko 4240 nastupa, nezaboravnih trenutaka uzbudljivih iskustava i predstavljanja muzičke umetnosti hiljadama obožavalaca širom svijeta. Ansambl CAS-a „Stiv Naumov“ je za 76 godina rada postigao veliki uspjeh i dobio visoke nagrade i priznanja. CAS „Stiv Naumov“ Bitola je 2019. godine proslavio 75 godina postojanja. Mešoviti hor postoji od svog osnivanja i broji 35 članova. Oba hora imaju veoma bogat i raznovrstan program uključujući muziku renesanse, baroka, klasičnu muziku, folklor i evergrin. CAS Stiv Naumov nije samo ambasador Bitolja već i ambasador horske muzike i gradi jake mostove između zemalja širom sveta. Mešoviti hor je najstariji i najpoznatiji ansambl u kulturno-umetničkom društvu koji je neprekidno radio od svog formiranja. Prvi put pod dirigentskom palicom Todora Skalovskog, hor je održao koncert 5. novembra kada je Bitolj oslobođen. Od 1969. godine do danas punih 51 godinu, vođa hora je g-din Ljubomir Trifunovski. U ovom periodu postignuti su najveći uspjesi i afirmacija u zemlji i inostranstvu. Pod dirigentskom palicom Ljubomira Trifunovskog, hor je učestvovao na festivalima u Češkoj, Poljskoj, Rumuniji, Sloveniji, Engleskoj, Grčkoj, Bugarskoj, Francuskoj, Italiji, Turskoj, Španiji, Mađarskoj, Srbiji, Hrvatskoj, Korzici, Bosni i Hercegovini, Nemačkoj i festivali u Tetovu (TEHO) i Ohridsko letu. Od 2021. godine mešoviti hor vodi dirigent Liljana Trajkovska Dimevski.



Cultural art society "Stiv Naumov" - Bitola is an association, established on November 11, 1944 in Bitola, by the group of enthusiastic members from the 7th Macedonian Partisan Brigade. In the past 76 years, Stiv Naumov has continued, enriched and designed the tradition of choral music in Bitola. During the 76 years of work of the ensemble we have held about 4240 performances, unforgettable moments of exciting experiences and presenting the art of the music to thousands of fans all around the world. The ensemble of CAS "Stiv Naumov" in the time of 76 years of work have achieved great success and received high awards and recognitions. In 2019, CAS "Stiv Naumov" Bitola celebrated its 75th anniversary. The mixed choir exists since its establishment and counts 35 members. Both choirs have a very rich and varied



program including Renaissance music, baroque, classical music, folklore and evergreens. CAS Stiv Naumov is not only ambassador of Bitola but also ambassador of the choir music and builds strong bridges between the countries around the world. Mixed choir The mixed choir is the oldest and the most famous ensemble in cultural art society which has worked continuously from its forming. For the first time conducted by Todor Skalovski the choir gave a concert on the 5th of November when Bitola was liberated. Direktor Trakijskog hora Muzeja Nove Orestijade je mr. Vasilejos Papamichail, profesor vizantijiske muzike, vodeći pojac naše lokalne Svete episkopije Didimotejhona, Orestijade i Sufliona. Takođe je inženjer hemije, završio je Politehničku školu Aristotelovog Univerziteta u Solunu. On je penzionisani profesor obrazovanja drugog razreda i radio je na poziciji direktora prvog Liceja u Novoj Orestijadi. Oženjen je i ima troje odrasle dece.



The Thracian Choir of the Museum of New Orestiada was established in 1993 and reformed the traditional song scene in the region of Northern Evros, giving cause to many other choirs, also with traditional repertoire, to be founded as well. The program of our choir includes thracian traditional songs, Minor Asia songs and folk songs from all over Greece. It comprises of 25-60 choristers, depending on the event and 5-10 instrumentalists. Our choir participated in remembrance festivities, in 1995, in the National Theatre of Northern Greece, in Thessaloniki. The choir, through the years, took part in many music festivals in all the cities and in most of the villages of our geographical unit, Evros Regional Unit. We entertained the soldiers in Army Celebrations Days, held in big local military camps, participated in a Panhellenic Encounter of The Old Boy Scouts Community, in our city in 1994. Our choir has also been invited to attend music festivals in many other cities in Greece, such as Xanthi, Kavala, Kozani, Katerini, Kastoria, in the island of Corfu, Lamia, Ptolemaida, Komotini etc. We also have received invitations and we responded to, by making appearances, in other countries all over the world, including Geneva and Zurich in Switzerland, Bucharest, Bistritsa and Targoviste in Romania, festive events of the Greek expatriate community in Konstantinoupoli and Princes' Islands in the Sea of Marmara and in many cities in Eastern Thrace, such as: Kirklareli, Silivri, Tekirdag, Edirne. We presented a special program in the 4th Worldwide Thracian Conference, held in New Orestiada in 1998. The biggest trip we ever had abroad was in 2008, when we were invited to participate in the International Multicultural Music and Dance Festival in the island of Macau, in Southeastern Asia. Our choir has recorded in a professional studio the following four CDs: 1) Historical traditional songs of Thrace and Macedonia. 2) Thracian songs of dance and love. 3) Thracian Christmas carols and carols from all over Greece. 4) Traditional songs from Konstantinopolis and Minor Asia. Director of the Thracian Choir of the Museum of New Orestiada is mr. Vasileios Papamichail, professor of byzantine music, lead chanter for our local Holy Bishopry of Didimoteichon, Orestiada and Souflion. He is also a chemical engineer, graduated from the Polytechnical School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He is a retired professor of the 2nd Grade Education and has served in the position of the Principal of the 1st Lyceum of New Orestiada. He is married and has three adult children.

U početku su hor činili samo učitelji. Međutim, brzo je primio mnoge talentovane lokalne stanovnike sa izuzetnim glasovima u svoje redove. Od 2016. godine LIGEIA sa velikim uspjehom organizuje Horski susret Grevena, a od 2019. godine je integrisana u novoosnovano Udruženje književnosti i umjetnosti područne jedinice Grevena. Učestvovali smo na brojnim horskim susretima u Serviji, Velvedu, Lamiji, Volosu, Solunu, Kavali, Livadiji, selima grčkog govornog područja Južne Italije, Eginiju itd. U februaru 2020. godine učestvovali smo na Međunarodnom festivalu horova u Koncertnoj dvorani Soluna i 21. maja 2022. na odgovarajućem Festivalu u Koncertnoj dvorani Atine.



Ove godine, od 15. do 16. marta, učestvovali smo na Festivalu horova i igara u organizaciji Zografeio Liceum u Istanbulu, povodom 130 godina od osnivanja Liceja. Glavni repertoar hora je grčko horsko pevanje koje obuhvata omaž poznatim grčkim kompozitorima kao što su Teodorakis i Hacidakis, kao i tradicionalne pjesme. Pored toga, hor prihvata i originalnu horsku muziku kakva je nastala od srednjeg vijeka pa nadalje. Trenutno broji oko 40 članova. Od 2014. godine, horom rukovodi dirigent Nikoleta Papazoglou, koja je svojom odličnom obučenošću, strpljenjem i istrajanju značajno doprinijela njegovom unapređenju.



The mixed polyphonic choir "Ligeia" was founded in 2012 by the Coordinators of School Activities in the Directorate of Education, Stergios Pournaras for the Secondary Education of Grevena, and Metaxia Fotiou for the Primary Education.

Initially, the choir consisted only of teachers. However, it quickly welcomed many talented local residents with exceptional voices into its ranks. Since 2016, LIGEIA has been organizing the Choral Meeting of Grevena with great success, and since 2019, it has been integrated into the newly founded Association of Letters and Arts of the Regional Unit of Grevena. We have participated in numerous choral meetings in Servia, Velvedo, Lamia, Volos, Thessaloniki, Kavala, Livadia, the Greek-speaking villages of South Italy, Aeginio, etc. In February 2020, we participated in the International Choir Festival at the Concert Hall of Thessaloniki and on May 21, 2022, at the corresponding Festival at the Concert Hall of Athens. This year, on March 15 - 16, we participated in the Festival of Choirs and Dances organized by Zografio Lyceum in Istanbul, commemorating the 130 years since the Lyceum's establishment.

The choir's main repertoire is Greek choral singing encompassing tributes to renowned Greek composers such as Theodorakis and Hatzidakis, as well as traditional songs. Additionally, the choir embraces the original choral music as it was shaped from the Middle Ages onwards. Currently, it boasts approximately 40 members. Since 2014, the choir has been directed by the conductor Nicoleta Papazoglou, who, with her excellent training, patience, and perseverance, has contributed significantly to its improvement.

- srebrnu medalju u kategoriji svetovne muzike na "Majskim muzičkim svečanostima" u Bijeljini.

Dirigentska palica je od 2020. godine u rukama Vesne Paunov.

Njen rad nije samo zapažen u školi, niti samo kao dirigent hora. Ona je i korepetitor i autor mnogih kompozicija koje hor izvodi.
